RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AND AUTHORIZING ST. TAMMANY PARISH GOVERNMENT TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR LEGAL SERVICES RELATED TO THE CASE ENTITLED MILITARY ROAD REVITALIZATION COMPANY, LLC AND BCP NORTHSHORE PROPERTIES, LLC VS. ST. TAMMANY PARISH GOVERNMENT, UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF LOUISIANA, CIVIL ACTION NO. 2:24-CV-00055 I (2).

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government is the defendant in the above referenced federal case; and

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government is committed to ensuring proper representation in a matter which requires a special level of legal expertise in a specific area of law; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Division of the District Attorney's Office for the 22nd Judicial District has acknowledged that said specialized legal expertise is required in this matter; and

WHEREAS, Brooks, Gelpi Haase', LLC has a team of uniquely qualified and experienced attorneys (the "Firm") who have decades of specialized legal expertise in the field of real estate, planning, zoning, etc.; and

WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Government has determined it to be in its best interest to enter into the Agreement with the Firm to defend St. Tammany Parish Government; and

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSED LA R.S. 13:5726.1 WHICH MAKES PROVISIONS RELATIVE TO THE CORONER OF ST. TAMMANY PARISH.

WHEREAS, in the 2013 Regular Session, the Louisiana Legislature enacted La. R.S. 13:5725, which repealed La. R.S. 13:5724 and transferred financial control of the Coroner's office to the St. Tammany Parish governing authority; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Legislature enacted La. R.S. 13:5726 which returned fiscal controls to the St. Tammany Parish Coroner's office; and

WHEREAS, the Parish President and members of the St. Tammany Parish delegation seek to enact La. R.S. 13:5726.1 and repeal La. R.S. 13:5726 to return all financial control of the Coroner's office to the St. Tammany Parish governing authority, as described in the attachment.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED that the St. Tammany Parish Council supports the enactment La. R.S. 13:5726.1 which makes provisions relative to the Coroner of St. Tammany Parish

- To enact R.S. 13:2726.1 and to repeal R.S. 13:5726 relative to the
- 2 coroner of St. Tammany Parish; to require the governing authority of St. Tammany
- 3 Parish to collect certain tax revenues levied for purposes of the St. Tammany Parish
- 4 coroner's office; to require all collected revenues to be deposited into a special account
- for designated use; to require the governing authority to establish an annual salary for the
- 6 St. Tammany Parish coroner; to require the governing authority to establish the salaries
- 7 of employees of the coroner's office; to provide for certain responsibilities of the
- 8 governing authority relative to the use of the tax proceeds; to provide for an effective
- 9 date; and to provide for related matters.
- Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
- 11 Section 1. R.S. 13:2726.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
- 12 §5727. St. Tammany Parish; coroner; powers and duties; compensation of coroner
- 13 and employees
- 14 A. The governing authority of St. Tammany Parish shall receive all tax revenues
- 15 collected from the ad valorem tax levied by St. Tammany Parish for coroner purposes
- and approved by a majority of the electors of the parish at an election held for that
- purpose on November 2, 2004, including any extensions or renewals thereof. The St.
- 18 Tammany Parish coroner's office shall transfer any and all funds on hand received from
- 19 the ad valorem tax to the governing authority of St. Tammany Parish, less and except
- amounts needed for operation for the remainder of calendar year 2024, with the amount
- being determined by the St. Tammany Parish Department of Finance. Any contracts or
- 22 purchase agreements entered into by the St. Tammany Parish coroner's office shall
- 23 require approval or ratification by the governing authority of St. Tammany Parish.
- 24 B. The revenues collected by the governing authority pursuant to Subsection A of this
- 25 Section shall be deposited into a special account and expended solely for the purposes set
- forth in the ad valorem tax proposition approved by the voters on November 2, 2004, less
- and except St. Tammany Parish's administrative fees, costs associated with
- administration of the ad valorem tax levied, St Tammany Parish's costs associated with
- oversight of the St. Tammany Parish coroner's office, and amounts necessary to service

- bonds or other debt obligations secured by the ad valorem tax. St. Tammany Parish shall
- 2 be deemed to have fully and completely met its obligations to fund the St. Tammany
- Parish coroner's office as set forth in R.S. 13:5706 and 5710 for the life of the ad valorem
- 4 <u>tax</u>. <u>Until the expiration of the ad valorem tax</u>, and notwithstanding any provisions of
- 5 law to the contrary, St. Tammany Parish shall not be obligated to pay any
- 6 other fee or cost and all obligations to the coroner are limited as provided for in this
- 7 Subsection.
- 8 C.(1) All salaries or fees associated with the operation of the coroner's office shall be
- 9 funded and paid from revenues collected pursuant to Subsection A of this Section.
- 10 (2) An annual salary shall be established by the governing authority of the parish of St.
- Tammany to be paid to the coroner in lieu of all fees for his services as parish coroner, ex
- officio parish physician, or health officer. The salary shall be the average of the salaries
- of the St. Tammany Parish sheriff, assessor, and clerk.
- 14 (3) The governing authority coroner shall also establish an annual salary for the deputy or
- assistant coroners, secretaries, stenographers, clerks, technicians, investigators, official
- photographers, or other employees.
- D. Within six months of the effective date of this Section, the governing authority of St.
- 18 Tammany Parish and the St. Tammany Parish coroner's office shall enter into a restated
- 19 cooperative endeavor agreement, including but not limited to the following provisions:
- 20 (1) Requiring use of all tax revenues in strict conformity with the tax proposition
- approved by the voters.
- 22 (2) Requiring compliance with public bid and procurement laws.
- 23 Section 2. R.S.13:5726 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
- signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without
- signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of
- 27 Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this
- Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
