Stanley LeGrange - this right-of-way has been a part of his family since 1946. The pecan trees were planted by his grandfather. The purpose of this appeal is to show that there was a bias against him on September 8. He has a picture of the Public Notice Sign which also shows that the property was revoked as a public street. He harvests the pecan trees on the property and has chicken coops. Henrietta Street is not listed as a road.

Victoria Warren - she has never heard of Henrietta Street. It is just an alley. It has never been abandoned. Dollar General has already torn down all the trees.

Jeff Schoen - represents the developer of the Dollar General Site on Highway 59. This is a simple case. They need to lay sewerage and water lines under the right-of-way. They will not open the street or clear cut the lot. The Parish Legal Department did extensive research and Henrietta is a valid and existing right-of-way, and this portion of it was not revoked. This laying of the pipes was approved by the staff. This is the way that people extend infrastructure. No one can possess or own public property, which is a matter of state law. It is his client's intent that the lines will be installed with little interruption to underbrush and trees. They also have no intentions to take Mr. LaGrange's shed. They just want to follow the path of least resistance. The Parish Planning and Legal Departments approved this matter.

Madeline LeGrange - she is the mother of Stanley. Stanley was talking about squatter's rights and that he owns the property by paying taxes on the property.

LeGrange - he was not informed about what was going to happen ahead of time, so that really was not the path of least resistance. There is not a lot of undergrowth because he goes in and clears it out. There is a walking path throught the property that allows people to reach the middle properties.

Schoen - if this is in fact public property, as indicated, then his client does not need approval to send a surveyor to look at the property. They are trying to be a good neighbor and not mention some of the activities that others have been conducting in the right-of-way without permission.
