RESOLUTION OF NO OBJECTION TO THE PROPOSED 2020 CENSUS TRACTS AND BLOCK GROUPS AS PRESENTED BY THE CENSUS BUREAU. (SMITH)

WHEREAS, the decennial census counts each person in the country, where they live on April 1, every 10 years ending in zero. The last census was in 2010, and the next census will be in 2020; and

WHEREAS, in preparation for that count the Census Bureau has created Census tracts within St. Tammany Parish whose purpose is to provide a set of nationally consistent, relatively small statistical units, with stable boundaries, that facilitate analysis of data across time; and

WHEREAS, each census tract is made up of no more than nine block groups which are statistical geographic subdivisions of a census tract; and

WHEREAS, the Parish has been provided the opportunity to review and if necessary, suggest updates to the boundaries of the block groups.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES that after review of the proposed census block groups the Parish has no objection to the boundaries as presented by the Census Bureau.
